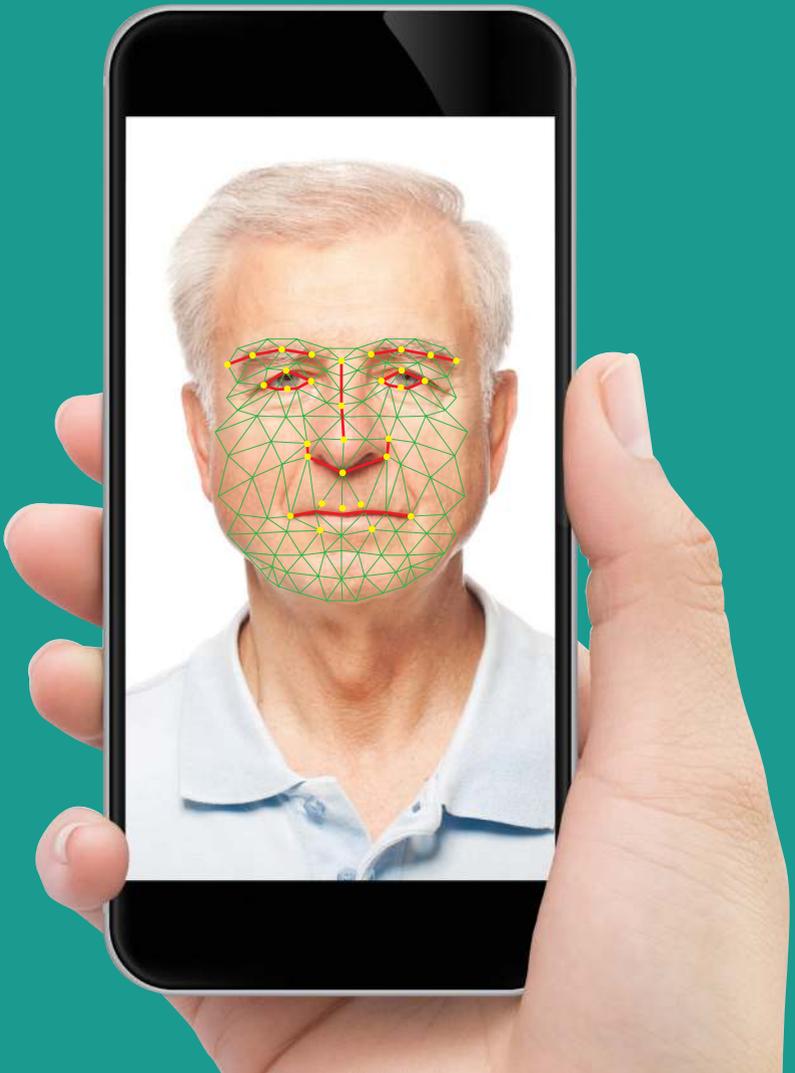




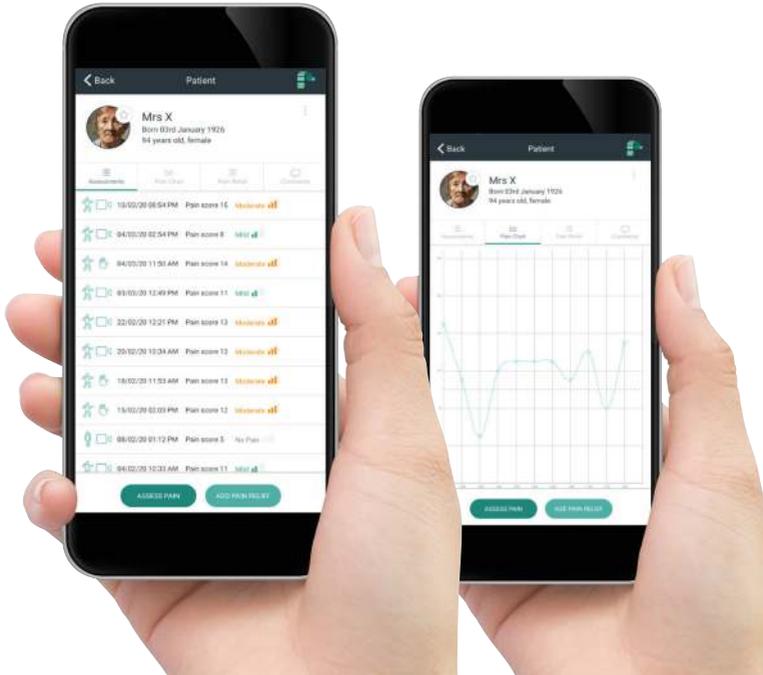

She struggles to tell her carers when she is in pain and how severe the symptoms are.

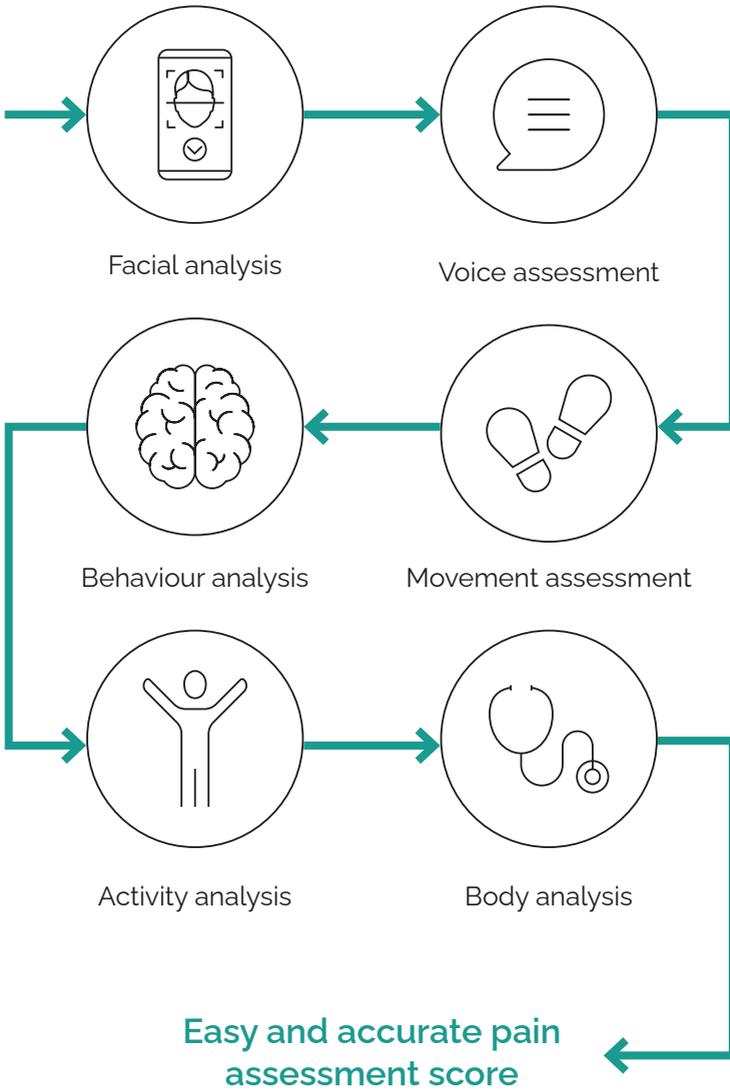
Luckily for Mary, her care home uses PainChek to allow them to quickly understand when Mary is in pain.

PainChek® is giving a voice to people who cannot verbalise their pain. 70% of people living within aged care in the UK live with some form of dementia. On top of this, 80% of the UK care home population live with chronic pain. The combination of these two factors creates a large population of people who are living with pain and may not be able to articulate their feelings. This is where PainChek® comes in.

The PainChek® App uses AI technology to identify facial expressions which are associated with pain; combined with other complementary assessment domains to produce a robust assessment score. PainChek's ability to manage pain means challenging behaviour is minimised, resulting in fewer residents being prescribed anti-psychotic medication.

By 2051 over 2 million people are expected to be living with dementia in the UK, many of whom will be living with chronic pain which often goes unnoticed.
